The Board rendered an Opinion and made the following Order: "**AND NOW**, this 29th day of June, 1988, upon consideration of the pleadings and the testimony presented, it is hereby **ORDERED** and **DECREED** that an award be made in favor of the Plaintiff, Alternatives Corporation of Pottstown, and against the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation, in the amount of Thirteen Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty-Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$13,954.50) plus Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) filing fee. Each party to pay its own costs other than the filing fee included in the award."
