


The Board rendered an Opinion and made the following Order: "AND NOW, this 21st day of July, 1989, premised on the record, the pleadings herein and the testimony presented, it is hereby ORDERED and DECREED that the Settlement Agreement and Mutual Release be and hereby is approved and that the Defendant, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Environmental Resources, is obligated to pay the sum of One Million Fourteen Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-Eight Dollars (\$1,014,668.00) in full satisfaction of all Claims filed and unfiled arising from Contract No. OSM 49(3662) 101.1 pertaining to the "Maysville Mine Fire" and that all terms, conditions and provisions of the Settlement Agreement and Mutual Release shall be effective.


