The Board rendered an Opinion and made the following Order: "**AND NOW**, this 10th day of August, 1989, upon due consideration of the Statement of Claim, the Stipulation and Agreement of the parties and other submissions it is **ORDERED** that the Defendant, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation, shall pay to Plaintiff, Modjeski and Masters, to the use of Geo-Technical Services, Inc., the sum of Seven Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty-Nine Dollars and Nine Cents (\$7,759.09), which amount shall include the Fifty-Dollar (\$50.00) filing fee paid by the Plaintiff to commence this action, in full satisfaction and settlement of the matter. Plaintiff shall withdraw its Statement of Claim and upon payment of the within award, file a Praecipe with the Board of Claims requested that the matter be marked settled and discontinued with prejudice.
