From this award, Two Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty-Eight Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$2,968.50) is for the use of Davis Landscaping. Interest shall be awarded thereon at the rate of 6% per annum from January 5, 1989. Bohlin, Powell, Larkin & Cywinski is

hereby awarded the sum of Twenty-Three Thousand Six Hundred Forty-Six Dollars and Twenty-Five Cents (\$23,646.25), which is the retainage due it against the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of General Services, with interest at the rate of 6% per annum from July 2, 1987.
