





The Board rendered an Opinion and made the following Order: "AND NOW, this 6th day of February, 1992, upon due consideration of the Agreement of the parties and other submissions, it is hereby ORDERED and DECREED that Defendant, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation, shall pay to Plaintiff, Perini Corporation, the sum of Three Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$315,000.00) in full satisfaction and settlement of the claims set forth in Plaintiff's Complaint. Plaintiff shall withdraw its Complaint and upon payment of the within award, file a Praecipe with the Board of Claims requesting that the matter be marked 'dismissed with prejudice'. Each party to bear its own costs." Copy forwarded to attorney for Plaintiff and attorney for Defendant.
