The Board rendered an Opinion and made the following Order: "**AND NOW**, this 10th day of March, 1995, upon receipt of a Letter Praecep, executed by Richard Kordesh, on his own behalf which states: 'The Claimant in this matter has received payment on the July 7, 1994 Order of the Board of Claims and therefore, respectfully requests the Board of Claims to enter upon its docket that this matter is **SETTLED, DISCONTINUED AND CLOSED**.' Same of which is docketed with this Board under date of February 15, 1995, it is **ORDERED** and **DIRECTED** that said case be marked 'settled, discontinued and ended with prejudice'."
