Board forwarded letter to plaintiff requesting that plaintiff file a praecipe.

**August 30, 2006**

Board issued Rule to Show Cause. Order as follows: **"AND NOW,** this 30<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2006, a Rule to Show Cause is issued upon Plaintiff, Dr. Linda Spears-Bunton, wherein it is **DIRECTED** that Plaintiff advise the Board, within 30 days from the exit date of this Order, as to whether or not Plaintiff wishes to pursue the above-captioned matter. In the event the Board does not receive an affirmative response to this Rule within said time frame, this Rule to Show Cause shall become absolute, and the case shall be marked closed, discontinued and ended with prejudice." Copies forwarded to parties.

**October 13, 2006**

Board rendered order. Order as follow: **AND NOW**, this 13<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2006, this Order is issued as a result of the failure of Plaintiff, Dr. Linda Spears-Bunton, to file with the Board of Claims, within thirty (30) days from August 30, 2006, a response to the Rule to Show Cause advising whether or not Plaintiff received the sum of money awarded in the Board's Opinion and Order.
