Plaintiff filed Claim and proof of mailing. Amount of Claim: \$66,387.63+.

March 28, 2006

March 30, 2006

Board issued Acknowledgment letter and forwarded a copy of the Claim to Attorney General.

April 5, 2006

Attorney General filed Acceptance of Service of Claim dated March 30, 2006. Receipt of same acknowledged April 03, 2006.

April 28, 2006

Defendant filed letter via facsimile requesting an extension of time until May 15, 2006 in which to respond to Plaintiff's Claim. Plaintiff agrees with Defendant's extension.

May 1, 2006

Board forwarded letter granting Defendant's request for an extension of time until May 15, 2006 in which to respond to Plaintiff's Claim.

May 2, 2006

Defendant filed letter via U.S. Mail requesting an extension of time until May 15, 2006 in which to respond to Plaintiff's Claim. Plaintiff agrees with Defendant's extension.

May 24, 2006

May 26, 2006

Diffenderffer, Esquire shall immediately notify this Board of any matter affecting their standing at the bar of any other court or jurisdiction where they may be admitted to practice. All correspondence with this Board shall continue to be accomplished through the Pennsylvania attorney of record unless otherwise requested in writing by the party." Copy forwarded to Plaintiff and Defendant.
