# May 13, 2008

By Order of the Commonwealth Court, case filed, Order as follows: "AND NOW, this 5<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2008, the above captioned action was originally filed in the Court of Common Pleas of Chester County (trial court). The civil complaint alleged that Katie Tran (Petitioner) was a student in the Bachelor of Science registered nurse program West Chest University (University). The complaint further averred that the University's undergraduate student handbook, sanctioned by the University's Department of Nursing, constituted a bilateral contract under which Petitioner and the University were bound. The complaint asserted that the University breached the contract and sought compensatory damages. University filed preliminary objections alleging, inter alia, that the trial court lacked jurisdiction because the case involved a breach of contract action naming a Commonwealth entity, the University, as defendant. The preliminary objections averred that the Board of Claims had exclusive jurisdiction over the action. order dated April 15, 2008, the trial court sustained the preliminary objections to jurisdiction and transferred the action to this Court. Based on our review of the pleadings, it is apparent that this Court does not have jurisdiction over the matter. Pursuant to Section 761 (a)(1)iv) of the Judicial Code, 42 Pa. C.S. §761(a)(1)(iv), "actions or proceedings conducted pursuant to the Act of May 20, 1937 (P.L. 728, No. 193), referred to as the Board of Claims Act" are excepted from this Court's original jurisdiction. By Act of December 3, 2002, P.L. 1147, the Board of Claims Act was repealed and new legislation continuing the Board of Claims is now found at 62 Pa. C.S. §§1721-1726. The provision for exception to the Commonwealth Court's original jurisdiction has not, however, been amended. Presently, Section 1724 of Title 62 addresses the Board of Claim's jurisdiction. As nothing in the new status or case law interpreting it suggests an intent to change the basic principle that the Board of Claims has exclusive jurisdiction over contractual claims against the Commonwealth government, we are constrained to transfer this action. Accordingly, this 5th day of May, 2008, this action is hereby transferred to the Board of Claims pursuant to 42 Pa. C.S. §5103(d).
