September 16, 2015

Order filed - Friedman, Rochelle S. Upon consideration of petitioner's application to expedite and the answer in the opposition thereto, the application is granted in part and denied in part. Respondent's brief in opposition to the preliminary objections (4 copies) shall be filed and served on or before October 5, 2015.
