The Board rendered the following Order: AND NOW, this 17th day of December, 1981, in accordance with Regulation 106, 4 Pa. Code 121.15, the Board is advised that a proposed settlement has been reached between the parties. By the terms of the proposal, the defendant will pay to the Plaintiff the full and final settlement sum of \$80,000.00. Said Notice of Proposed Settlement further sets forth that it is understood and agreed between the parties that the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of General Services, will exercise a good-faith effort to make payment to the Plaintiff on or before December 18, 1981. Further, provision is made for mutual releases to be executed by the parties. The Notice of Proposed Settlement was executed on behalf of the Commonwealth by Barbara Sumple Sullivan, Assistant Counsel, and Kenneth I. Levin, Esquire, on behalf of the Plaintiff. It is ORDERED and DIRECTED that the case be marked "settled, discontinued and ended with prejudice". In the event, for reasons unbeknown at this time, that the settlement is not fully consummated within the terms of the proposed agreement, then, in that event, Plaintiff may file with this Board a Petition to Reopen the Record and permit the hearing to proceed on the merits."
