Complaint and filing fee filed. Amount of claim: \$5,000.00+.

July 1, 1980

Copies of claim forwarded to attorney for defendant and Deputy Attorney General.

July 23, 1980

Letter entering appearance received from Mr. Skubecz.

August 25, 1980

Answer filed by attorney for defendant. Copy forwarded to attorney for plaintiff by attorney for defendant.

December 10, 1980

Hearing scheduled for March 17 through 20, 1981, in Board's Court Room at 10 a.m.

March 17, 1981

Hearing held in Board's Court Room at 10 a.m. Case completed.

April 2, 1981

Testimony of hearing held March 17, 1981, filed. Copy forwarded to attorney for defendant.

April 21, 1981

Suggested Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Memorandum in support filed by attorney for plaintiff. Copy forwarded to attorney for defendant by attorney for plaintiff.

May 6, 1981

Suggested Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Memorandum in support filed by attorney for defendant. Copy forwarded to attorney for plaintiff by attorney for defendant.

September 30, 1981

The Board rendered an Opinion and made the following Order: "AND NOW, this 30th day of September, 1981, the Board of Claims finds in favor of the Claimant, John M. Hohenwarter, and against the Defendant, Department of Transportation, in the amount of \$5,000 plus interest at six (6%) per cent per annum from August 31, 1979." Copies of Opinion and Order forwarded to attorney for plaintiff and attorney for defendant.

December 8, 1981

Satisfaction of Judgment filed by attorney for plaintiff.

December 17, 1981

The Board rendered the following Order: "AND NOW, this 17th day of December, 1981, pursuant to Satisfaction of Judgment, dated November 21, 1981, and signed by John G. Younglove, Esquire, attorney for the Plaintiff, same of which is docketed with this Board under date of December 8, 1981, wherein it would appear from reading same that a check in the amount of \$5,664.11 was forwarded to Mr. Hohenwarter in settlement of this captioned matter. Further, acknowledgment was made that the sum received represents full and complete satisfaction of the judgment entered by the Board of Claims relative to the above captioned matter, and any and all claims which might arise therefrom. Therefore, it is ORDERED and DIRECTED that the case be marked "satisfied, discontinued and ended with prejudice". Copies of Order forwarded to attorney for plaintiff and attorney for defendant.
