January 11, 1982 The Board rendered the following Order: "The instant matter was convened as scheduled at 10 a.m. on December 8, 1982, before the Board of Claims. Plaintiff, Consolidated Rail Corporation, was represented by Don Leatherman, Esquire, and the Defendant, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Liquor Control Board, was represented by J. Leonard Langan, Assistant Counsel. Upon record was placed agreement of counsel that the matter reached settlement, and that only thereafter was the requirement of certain approvals by the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Mr. Leatherman and Mr. Langan set forth of record their concurrence in the agreed settlement. It was ascertained that the conduct of counsel was not an endeavor to continue the case, but an endeavor to settle same. The record is replete with the scope of authority of the parties representing their respective clients. The Board is satisfied that the matter has been settled, therefore, the record is DIRECTED to be closed. In the event, for reasons unforeseen at this time, the settlement is not fully consummated, then in that event, the Plaintiff may petition this Board requesting that the record be opened and that the Plaintiff be permitted to proceed with the hearing of the case on the merits."
