In regard to Count Two, we find in favor of the Defendant, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of General Services and the Additional Defendants, John P. Gilboy, Jr., Randolph J. Stauffer, Robert J. Giombetti, James T. Skibinski, Edward T. Davies, & Colin J. Gilboy trading as Gilboy, Stauffer, Giombetti, Skibinski and Davies and against the Claimant, Andrew Hreha & Sons, Inc. Each of the parties to bear their own costs."
