September 20, 1982 Petition for Suspension of Proceedings filed by attorney for defendant. Copy forwarded to attorney for plaintiff by attorney for defendant.

October 12, 1982 The Board rendered an Opinion and made the following Order: "AND NOW, this 12th day of October, 1982, upon agreement of the parties through their respective counsel, Petition for Suspension of Proceedings is GRANTED and all matters shall be suspended until one of the parties shall file a praecipe to resume this matter after which the Respondent shall have thirty (30) days to file its reply to the claim or this matter is resolved and settled. The Board directs that a status report shall be filed with the Board every ninety (90) days from the date of this Order so that the Board will be current in its knowledge of the progress of the case." Copies forwarded to attorney for plaintiff and attorney for defendant.

April 15, 1985 Stipulation of Settlement filed by attorney for defendant and executed by attorney for plaintiff and attorney for defendant

April 22, 1985 AND NOW, this 22nd day of April, 1985, premise on the above matters herein set forth, the record and the Stipulation of Settlement entered into by the parties through Attorney Bruce G. Baron, on behalf of the Department of Public Welfare and Attorney Terry Bossert on behalf of the law firm of McNeese, Wallace & Nurick, counsel for the Claimant and taking into consideration paragraph 4 which calls for a payment of a certain sum within sixty days of the date of this Order, the Board ORDERS and DIRECTS that the Stipulation of Settlement be entered of record and that the case be settled and discontinued with prejudice. In the event any of the matters contained in said Stipulation are not consummated, then in that event, either party through their counsel may petition this board to open the case for hearing.
