Further, it is set forth in this Order that it is directed that the Claimant hold harmless the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania from any claims or actions by the estate of any recipient involved with this matter which arises from the Department of Public Welfare's agreement to make payment to the Claimant rather than to such estate - up to the amount of the payment made with respect to such recipient - further said Commonwealth is to be held harmless from any disallowance of PFP (Federal Financial Participation) in these payments to Claimant arising solely from the Department of Public Welfare's agreement to make payment to Claimant up to the amount of such disallowance, providing further that the Claimant shall have the right to contest and defend the Department of Public Welfare against any such claims."
