September 4, 1984 The Board rendered an Opinion and made the following Order: "AND NOW, this 4th day of September, 1984, a Rule to Show Cause why the Claim should not be discontinued upon Defendant's Praecipe is hereby issued upon the Plaintiff. The Rule shall be made absolute within thirty (30) days from the date hereof unless Plaintiff files Objections and reasons therefore within such period." October 24, 1984 The Board rendered an Opinion and made the following Order: "AND NOW, this 24th day of October, 1984, upon Plaintiff's failure to reply to the Rule to Show Cause why the Claim should not be discontinued as issued September 4, 1984, said Rule is hereby made absolute and the Claim of Driscoll Construction Company, Inc. is discontinued."
