The Board rendered an Opinion and made the following Order: "AND NOW, this 20th day of June, 1986, the Board finds as follows: A. Plaintiff is entitled to \$36,892.22 together with interest at the legal rate of six (6%) percent per annum beginning from March 11, 1983, the date of filing. B. Plaintiff is not entitled to \$12,772.00 for the unused pilings purchased for Piers 1, 2 and 3. C. Plaintiff is not entitled to \$30,528.00 for the alleged, unusual, additional excavations. D. Each party to bear its own costs."
